## 4.1.3 Availability and adequacy of general campus facilities and overall ambience

The College & Hospital spans an area of roughly 4 acres. The site has a girls' dorm and an IT hub center that serves as a post office for students to access email and messaging services. Roads are constructed with paver bricks.

The facility includes a college and an adjacent hospital that has pediatrics and orthopedic units. The girl's dorm, which is available to 50% of enrolled students, is situated in the same location as the College. The space is nicely organized and has sufficient vegetation, including a 2-acre playground, a 1-acre building area, and half an acre of decorative and fruit trees. The plants that have been cultivated possess therapeutic properties that contribute to the educational development of the kids.

The co-located Hospital provides students with sufficient medical services. Each ward has a certain number of 3-bedrooms reserved exclusively for students.

There is a separate restroom for males and females on every level. There are 12 distinct departments at the institution, each of which has its own dedicated restroom for faculty members. The institution has a meticulously designed Canteen that offers top-notch food products at an affordable price.

The college has sufficient and appropriate signage. The college campus generates power via the use of solar panels. Three water coolers are installed to provide sufficient water supply for both workers and students. A 70 KVA generator is provided as a backup to address any electrical outage or fluctuation. The campus is using collected garbage to produce compost manure. The biomedical wastes are disposed of by the personnel of Nashik Municipal Corporation.

The co-located Hostel can accommodate a total of 207 females. Annually, around 170 to 200 females use the hostel accommodation. Currently, there are 200 females using the hostel service. The hostel offers rooms that are furnished enough and have good ventilation. The hostel offers round-the-clock water and electricity supplies, a hot water connection powered by solar panels, and a fire extinguisher. The hostel also offers lunch and breakfast services. The institution acts as a guarantee for boys' lodging.
