4.2.1: Teaching Hospital, equipment, clinical teaching-learning and laboratory facilities are as stipulated by the respective Regulatory Bodies

The Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital has a hospital located inside its campus. This hospital is operated by the Education Welfare Trust. This hospital was founded in 2018. The hospital has a maximum capacity of 40 beds available for the admission of patients requiring indoor care.

The facility has an Outpatient Department (OPD), an Orthopedic unit, and a Pediatrics ward. The hospital is equipped with a well-equipped Intensive Care Unit (ICU) that includes patient monitors, inline oxygen delivery, 4 ventilators, and other life-saving equipment and medications.

OT has the necessary capabilities to do significant surgical procedures, such as joint replacements. Provisions are included for labor and aseptic operating theaters. The wards consist of separate sections for males and females, as well as an isolation ward equipped with in-line oxygen delivery. The Physiotherapy section is well equipped and collaborates with Facilities to ensure all preparations are in accordance with the prescribed requirements.

Clinical teaching and learning activities are conducted according to the clinical calendar for prefinal and final undergraduate student housemen. In addition, the doctors and surgeons who are oncall are assigned the responsibility of conducting clinical teaching and training for students. The institution has established joint Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) with many hospitals located near the college campus.

The pathology laboratory is furnished with state-of-the-art equipment, including a contemporary auto analyser, computerized cell counter, COVID analyser, ABG analyser, and computerized PFT unit. All Pathology tests are performed at the affiliated laboratory on a philanthropic basis. The pathology laboratory offers clinical pathology training to second-year BHMS students as per the designated schedule. It aids in research endeavors by providing evidence-based pathology reports for students' dissertations. Our facility offers a range of medical investigations, including Clinical Pathology and Biochemistry, Radiology, ECG, and USG. These services are provided at affordable rates.

The hospital has rendered invaluable assistance by distributing medications to more than 3.3 million individuals throughout the Covid epidemic. Furthermore, our company serves as a hub for Hemophilia therapy and has provided medical care to a total of 230 individuals.

The hospital offers a range of facilities, including a physiotherapy and naturopathy section that provides services such as hydrotherapy, meditation, and yoga treatment.
