4.3.1: Library is automated using Integrated Library Management System (ILMS)

The Homoeopathic College & Hospital has an Integrated Library Management System (LBM). The LBM software is primarily utilized in diverse planning processes to monitor the inventory of books and journals, their distribution within the library, as well as for managing students' data and correspondence, including admission information, fee collection records, outstanding fees, and applications for college leaving certificates. Additionally, it aids in the generation of all the reports and returns.

Synthesis LBM (ERP) software is used to partly automate the Central Library. The synthesis refers to a system used for managing an institute. This technology facilitates streamlined library management to accommodate user services effectively.

A library program is used to automate the management of books and journals, including record-keeping, tracking issues and returns, and doing stocktaking. The librarian extensively use this software. A library website is now being developed for the specific goal of facilitating library use.

An ILMS, or Library Management System (LMS), is an ERP system designed specifically for libraries. This system is used to monitor and record the ownership of resources, the placement of orders, the payment of bills, and the specific information about customers who have borrowed a certain book.

The ERP system comprises the following modules: The circulation module in the library facilitates the lending and returning of resources to customers. It allows for the issuance, return, and renewal of books, non-print materials (such as CDs and DVDs), and serials (such as print journals and magazines). Within this module, individuals have the ability to perform actions such as borrowing, returning, extending, or reserving a wide range of library resources, including audio, video, print, and non-print items.

The acquisition module allows the library to keep track of their library-related records using an accession register. This register includes information such as the title, author, accession number, topic, publisher, location of publishing, book vendor, kinds of documents, ISBN, and class number.

Cataloguing - The library catalogue serves as a substitute for the whole library collection. It facilitates the identification of the whereabouts of library resources inside the library. Within the central library,
