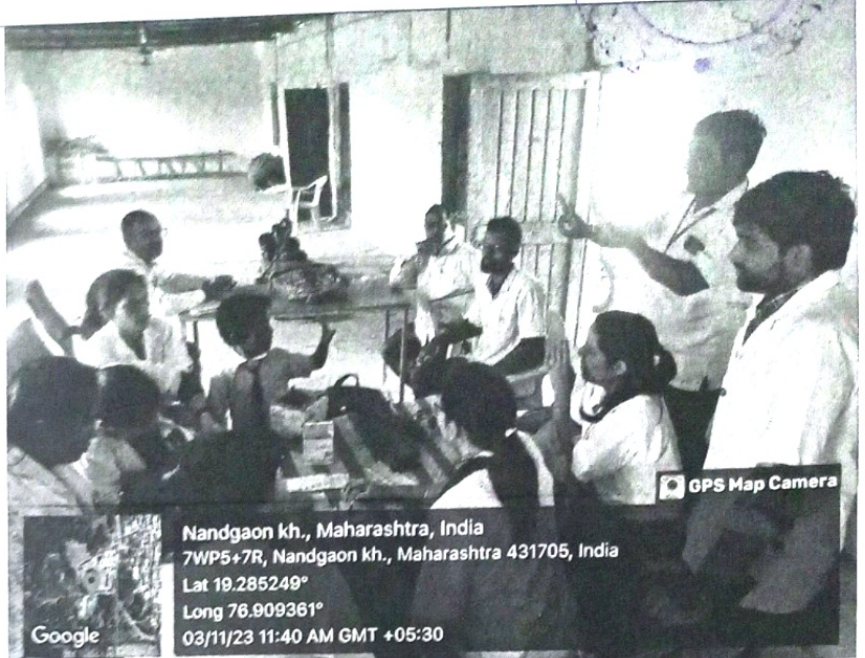
Description

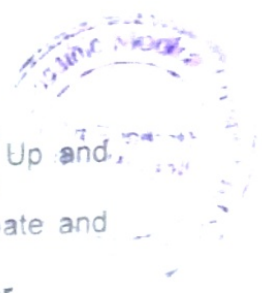
